2 <sup>nd</sup> May	Eph 2:1-10	Rooted in Christ: Transformed
9 <sup>th</sup> May	Eph 3	Rooted in Christ: Messengers
16 <sup>th</sup> May	Eph 4:1-7, 11-end	Rooted in Christ: United
23 <sup>rd</sup> May (Pentecost)	Eph 5: 15-end	Rooted in Christ: Spirit-filled/Holy
30 <sup>th</sup> May	Eph 6: 10-20	Rooted in Christ: Steadfast
