



## Privacy Notice – Young People

### Your personal data – what is it?

Personal Data is any info about you that allows you to be identified ie – name, photo's, video's, email address, profile names

### Who are we?

St Stephens church PCC is the data controller for your data. We are part of The Church of England and we work together with other organisations within The Church of England.

### What data do the data controllers listed above process?

Names, titles, and aliases, photographs;  
Contact details such as telephone numbers, addresses, and email addresses;  
We may have medical (including the name of your doctor) and dietary information.  
Which school you attend and in which year.

### What do we do with your data?

We may use your personal data for some or all of the following purposes:

- To send you communications and gain your consent for events that you may be interested in
- To seek your views or comments;
- To notify you of changes to our services, events and role holders
- To take a register of when you attend groups

### Sharing your personal data

We will not share your data with anyone else.

### How long do we keep your personal data?

We will keep your data as long as you are a member of our church.

### Your rights and your personal data

You have the following rights with respect to your personal data:

1. The right to access information we hold on you
2. The right to correct and update the information we hold on you
3. The right to have your information erased
4. The right to object to processing of your data
5. The right to withdraw your consent to the processing at any time for any processing of data to
6. The right to object to the processing of personal data where applicable.



7. The right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office.
